Because I studied finance, it's important for me to give to an organization that invests my money effectively. Before giving to Centraide, I reviewed non-profit impact ratings, such as those of Charity Intelligence, to make sure my donation would truly support its mission and have the greatest possible impact. Centraide identifies where needs are in real time so that it can invest in the most impactful agencies. When I give to Centraide, I know the money is being maximized to help vulnerable people in Greater Montreal.

My giving wasn't as structured as it is today, as I used to make one-off donations, such as to encourage a friend in a marathon or contribute to a flood relief fundraiser. My husband and I lived in Morocco for a year, and we realized how lucky we are in Quebec to have community agencies that do important work to fight poverty and social exclusion. When you give to Centraide, you cover the essentials at the base of Maslow's hierarchy of needs. ”

“If you're too busy to volunteer, you may have some money to donate. On the other hand, if you're on a tight budget, you might have some time to get involved in our community. I think most people have something to offer, it's just a question of what form your giving can take.”

I grew up watching my mother, who was a very generous woman, industriously stuff little envelopes with donations. We would always collect items for the food drive, an activity that was sacrosanct in our family. She would also volunteer at a long-term care centre every Saturday, even though she worked Monday to Friday. That example she set for me is the one I now want to share. The values I want to pass on to my family are definitely altruism and generosity.

What got me involved with Centraide was its role in meeting funding needs. Since most community agencies aren't funded, they have to spend vast amounts of time and effort on fundraising. So that's what Centraide does. Every year, it funds over 350 agencies and projects to let them focus on their core mission.

I'm also really concerned about the urgent need to meet basic needs and about the success of young people. Education is an essential tool that helps us develop throughout our adult lives. If we want everyone to be free to make their own choices, the essentials must be in place from an early age. ”

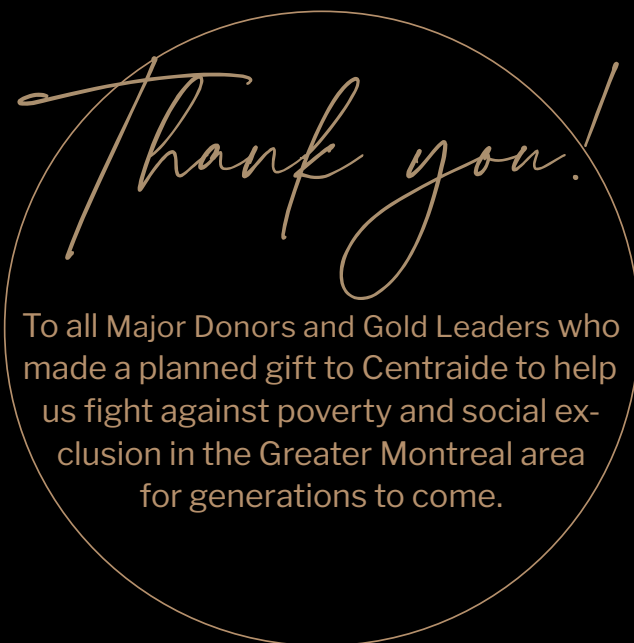

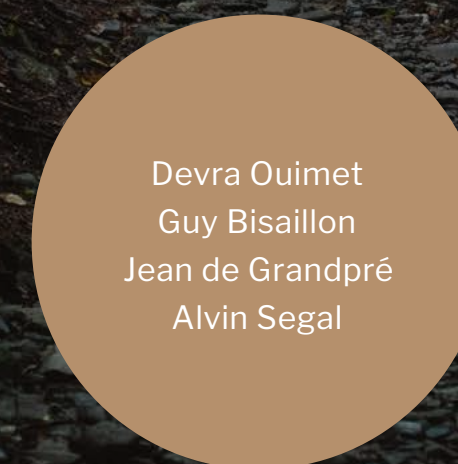
