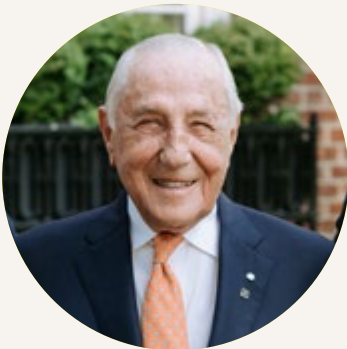

"When I was a kid, I saw my mom doing a lot of volunteering. We didn't have a lot of money but my parents always found a way to donate a few dollars to fundraisers. So I grew up with values of generosity and giving ingrained in me.

When I joined McCarthy Tétrault more than 20 years ago, I saw that the firm actively supports Centraide. I always contributed what I could afford because I had confidence in Centraide. Why so? Because Centraide funds non-profit agencies that help the Montreal community. When you give to Centraide, the bulk of the money goes directly to where the need is greatest. As individual donors, we can't always know whether an agency's work is meaningful and has a lasting impact, so we rely on Centraide to perform those checks and direct the funds where they will do the most good in the long term.

I firmly believe that we must invest in education and fighting poverty in Montreal. Many social problems, such as violence and crime, are linked to poverty. If people don't have food or shelter, other problems arise. Quebec is growing fast thanks to immigration and it's imperative to make sure newcomers can integrate, find jobs and build new lives.
