What makes Centraide particularly compelling to the Foundation is its ability to identify and support grassroots agencies working on the front lines.

"Centraide has a proven track record of success and professionalism," Mark Pathy notes.

By guiding donors toward the most impactful initiatives and strengthening the agencies behind them, Centraide ensures that every contribution is leveraged for maximum effect.

This alignment is especially important for addressing complex social challenges such as homelessness, one of the Foundation's key priorities. In a time of growing needs, ensuring access to essentials such as food and shelter is a critical starting point.

Through Centraide, the Foundation is able to support a network of community agencies working collectively to meet these needs, while also building longer-term solutions. The Foundation's approach is also inspired by an entrepreneurial mindset, one that values innovation, collaboration and scalability. It seeks to support initiatives that not only respond to immediate needs, but can also evolve, expand and inspire new ways of tackling social issues.

Through its partnership with Centraide, the Foundation continues to champion a philanthropic model that is structured, collaborative and focused on lasting impact.

From Halifax to Montreal: An Unbroken Line of Commitment

For George Armoyan and his family, philanthropy is above all a willingness to take concrete action. Here and in other parts of the world, they have chosen to support causes that make tangible differences in people's lives.

Before settling in Montreal, the family lived in Halifax, where they were already involved with Centraide, known there and elsewhere in the country as United Way. This first experience shaped their understanding of a structured philanthropy capable of meeting a range of needs within a single community.

When they arrived in Montreal a few years ago, George Armoyan, his wife and their sons naturally wished to carry on this commitment in their new environment. "When you are privileged, it's natural to give back," he says.

Among the causes the family members hold especially dear: the well-being of children and the conditions that enable them to grow up in a safe environment. For the family, a visit to a community agency in Verdun supported by Centraide of Greater Montreal was a key moment. "It made us realize

the significant challenges some young people face and how adapted resources can change things," the father shared.

Having experienced their own fair share of immigration, adaptation and perseverance, the Armoyans place great value on looking out for others and on making opportunities for fulfillment within reach of all. Along the way, they have supported a diversity of initiatives, as much in their community of origin as in Canadian society.

It was with this in mind that their commitment to Centraide of Greater Montreal made perfect sense. The organization's capacity to support a wide range of agencies and tackle the root causes of poverty coincided with their desire to have a systemic impact consistent with their philanthropic approach.

For George Armoyan and his family, contributing is about being part of a collective effort: to build a stronger community, where each person has a place in the sun and the means to thrive.

Cultivating Philanthropy

For Montrealers Roula and Alan Rossy, philanthropy isn't a once-in-a-while gesture: it's a culture, patiently cultivated over time.

Their commitments are varied. From health and education to the arts, all are united by a deep commitment to community service and causes they truly believe in. Their approach is carefully thought out, but above all it is profoundly human: giving where the impact is real, tangible and lasting.

This way of giving is part of a broader vision, one built on a simple conviction: philanthropy is everybody's business. "Everyone has the ability to give something," says Roula Rossy. "Whether it's time, attention or resources, every form of commitment helps to build solidarity in a society."

They have passed this philosophy on to their children, who are growing up in an environment where commitment comes to life on a daily basis. For them, giving becomes a reflex, a heritage made all the more fruitful from one generation to the next.

Their involvement with Centraide of Greater Montreal is a natural part of this. For Roula and Alan Rossy, the organization represents much more than a support network: it acts as a real pillar

of the community. "Centraide is like a mother taking care of many children," says Roula Rossy, describing an organization able to meet a multitude of needs, while ensuring rigorous and consistent resource management.

This trust is essential. Giving, for them, is more than a financial gesture: it's a commitment that has to be sincere and aligned with deeply held values. "It has to come from the heart," says Alan Rossy.

In a context where the social challenges grow more complex every day, Roula and Alan Rossy believe more than ever in the strength of community. Supporting an organization like Centraide, which acts both proactively and in response to the reality on the ground, not only helps people in the moment, but attacks the deep-rooted causes of inequality itself.

Cultivating philanthropy, for the Rossys, is precisely that: acting today, while contributing to sustainably transform the future.

Acting Locally, Thinking Systemically

For Audrey Moores, philanthropy runs in the family. As a child, she watched her grandmother write cheques to charities. “It was second nature to her,” Audrey recalls. “Giving was just part of life.”

The idea of collective responsibility took on deeper meaning about ten years ago. After the death of her father, an inheritance prompted a fundamental question: how could she give back in a way that aligned with her values?

Now a professor and researcher at McGill University, Audrey lives in Montreal, a city she describes as vibrant and magnificent. Yet every day, she witnesses the distress on its streets. “You can’t live in Montreal without seeing people experiencing homelessness,” she says. “When you love this city, it’s vitally important to give back.”

That’s where Centraide of Greater Montreal comes in. What resonates most with Audrey is Centraide’s ability to act locally, where the real needs are, while never losing sight of the big picture.

“What I like about Centraide is its systemic approach,” she explains. “They distribute the donations they collect where the impact will be greatest, even if it’s a less visible cause.”

As a scientist, Audrey is particularly interested in research on effective altruism, a movement that seeks to measure impact, grasp the complexity of social issues and avoid simplistic solutions to complex problems.

“When each person gives individually, without an overview, we don’t always act where the need is greatest,” she says. “Centraide brings all the pieces together, allowing us to act as a community.”

Audrey sees Centraide as an organization that channels individual goodwill into a broad collective response, transforming our awareness of our own privilege into an effective effort to share that privilege with every member of the community.

Preserving Montreal's Social Fabric

Yann N. Dauphin does research with global reach but he has always remained deeply attached to Montreal. He loves his city and wants to help preserve its unique social fabric. “Montreal has something precious,” he says. “It would be tragic to see this city’s social fabric unravel.”

Yann is an internationally respected AI researcher who earned his Ph.D. at Université de Montréal under the supervision of Yoshua Bengio. He now works at Google’s Montreal office. He joined Centraide's Major Donors’ Circle in 2024.

His mentor Hugo Larochelle, a Centraide ambassador, first made him aware of the organization. One day, Hugo invited him to a Mila Techaide* conference to share his AI expertise. Techaide attendees sign up to deepen their knowledge of AI but they also contribute to a worthy cause when they buy their ticket, as the proceeds from the event are donated to Centraide.

The intersection of science and social engagement at Techaide sparked something in Yann. He realized how events of this type can raise awareness by reaching people where their interests lie. “I felt like I was sowing small seeds of collective engagement,” he says.

A few years later, it was Yann’s turn to organize a Mila Techaide conference. He saw firsthand that matching attendees’ donations encouraged them to give more. Yann hopes to have a positive impact globally through his research and locally by giving to Centraide and supporting his community.

“Often, we see a problem and think, someone should do something about that,” he says. “I realized that someone could be me. I try to do my part, in my way.”

Commitment That Transcends Time

Long before becoming one of Centraide's most committed voices, H       V. Gagnon discovered the organization in the simplest way possible: while working on a company fundraiser. It was the beginning of a remarkable commitment.

For her, privilege is a call to responsibility. "I was lucky enough to have a good education, support and opportunities. That's not the case for everybody," she says. Her growing awareness gave way to a clear desire: to contribute so that each person had access to the basic essentials they needed to advance.

As her career progressed, first at Bombardier, then at CAE, H       V. Gagnon didn't just participate in Centraide's campaigns: she helped to transform them. Involved, motivated, she sought to mobilize people, to create unifying, positive and meaningful moments. "I wanted people to be eager for the Centraide campaign to begin," she explains. Driven by her momentum, these initiatives became real catalysts for collective commitment, with the ability to rally colleagues and leaders around a common cause.

Her leadership and capacity to inspire did not go unnoticed. She gradually broadened her involvement, most notably on the Major Donors Cabinet, where she now plays an active role in philanthropy development. There, she cultivates a spirit of collaboration and

transmission, while paying particular attention to the place of women in philanthropy, seeking to inspire more of them to engage. "We sow the seeds," she remarks. "Sometimes it takes time, but the idea develops in people's heads, gets them thinking and ends up turning into a significant gesture."

If H       V. Gagnon has been committed to Centraide for such a long time, it is because she has a deep dedication to the organization. "We each have our expertise," she explains. "Centraide's is to understand the needs of communities and identify where the donations will have the greatest impact." For her, Centraide acts as a social net, indispensable for supporting people and preserving community balance.

Over the years, the causes that affect her have evolved, but her commitment has never waned. Today she is particularly sensitive to the isolation of the elderly. "It's a situation that affects me deeply," she reflects. "No one should end their life alone." In her eyes, supporting Centraide is about continuing to build a more human community, one that is more attentive to each of us at every stage in life.

Give, Because It's Essential

Samira Sakhia is a successful businesswoman who works in a demanding and highly competitive environment. But deep down, there's one conviction that guides her actions: giving back is part of the balance. For Samira, giving is a reflex, practically a foregone conclusion, rooted in her childhood. "I grew up with the idea that making room for others at the table was natural," she says.

Samira comes from a culture where sharing is part of daily life, and early on she understood that each person has a role to play in supporting their community. "Donating has always been part of my life."

She explains. "I don't even have to think about it for long," she explains.

From the start of her career, Samira has been committed to giving, modestly at first, and then consistently. For her, it's not the amount that counts, but the gesture. "Whether it's \$10, \$50 or more than that, it makes a difference," she says simply.

In Montreal as elsewhere, the needs are very real, and sometimes closer to home than you'd imagine. Samira remembers an episode that marked her deeply: only a few minutes from her home, she saw a person living in their car. "It wasn't a scene you'd naturally associate with our neighbourhood," she says. "It shows how someone's situation can change overnight."

This growing awareness strengthened her conviction. "We live in a society where we're so privileged," she says. "But that's not the case with everybody. Helping to close that gap is so vital."

This is what has motivated her to support Centraide of Greater Montreal for over 20 years. For her, it's a simple and effective way to meet a wide variety of needs. "I trust the process," she says. "I know that the funds are being used well and that they're going where it counts."

As a leader, she also believes in the importance of mobilizing those around her. In her organization, she encourages participation and values collective engagement. "You often hear of social engagement, but you've got to take action, too," she says.

For Samira, philanthropy must remain accessible. She likes to bring it down to tangible gestures within anyone's reach. "What you spend on a coffee may seem trivial, but cumulatively it's equivalent to a budget that can put food on someone's table," she says.

Her message is clear: giving should not be perceived as a sacrifice, but as a simple choice. "It's easy to think that you can't do much," she concludes, "But when we all make an effort, it changes everything."
